- 2004 – 2005. Life Church South Campus Oklahoma City, Oklahoma- My wife and I are Life Coaches, Life Group Leaders, Work in Konnect and I work in LifeKids. We are active in worship and fellowship.
- 2003 – 2004. Foster Care Ministry- We were able to be parents to abused and neglected children from a few days old to 2 years old. We are currently waiting for our girls to be older before continuing in this ministry.
- 2000 – 2005. Multimedia Ministry- Helping churches and organizations with media equipment technical support and consulting, and presentation software. I worked in graphic design, video, and web design with Fowler Productions and Vision Magazine in Norman Oklahoma to help inform others in "Ministry through Multimedia. - 1991 – 1994. First Indian Baptist Church, Shawnee, Oklahoma- I was a volunteer co-youth, co-singles director, Sunday school teacher/director and camp counselor. I was active in planning, organizing and implementing visitation, and jail ministry.
- 1989 – 1991. I was involved in various outreach and fellowship ministries with youth and young adults at Oklahoma Baptist University and local churches in Shawnee, Oklahoma.
- 1986 – 1989. Victory Baptist Church, Fort Gibson, Oklahoma- Started from home bible studies; I helped plant and was the volunteer pastor. We were a laid back, casual dress, and come as you are church. We emphasized simple to understand, practical, relevant teaching and we saw many lives changed in a small town. We were known as “The kids Church” because of all the kids and youth that attended and were involved in all the different ministries of the church. I also acted as the children’s, youth and young adult minister. I was active in visitation, youth and young adult hangout outreach, street witnessing, and occult ministry. My van and I were the bus ministry. I taught various ages from small kids to adults. I was also a camp counselor for our children/youth camps.
- 1984 – 1986. Oklahoma Baptist University, Shawnee, Oklahoma- I was active in various outreach, discipleship, preaching and drama/comedy ministries through the Baptist Student Union and local churches. I was a Co-director of the students going to the Mission Center, Women’s Shelter, Grace Rescue Mission, Street Ministry and Visitation on Friday nights in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma and I was a “Freshmen Encourager”.
- 1985. Dixie Southern Baptist Church, Mississauga Ontario, Canada- I was a volunteer Summer Missionary, taught Sunday school, worked with children and youth, street witnessing, youth hangout, outdoor concerts, backyard bible schools, visitation and preached.
- 1985. Camp Iron Bell (a rugged children/youth camp in a national forest area), upper state New York. I cleared fields, trails, cabins in the woods and camp fire areas of brush and trees. Then I was a camp counselor for junior high boys from churches in Canada and New York.
- 1981 – 1984. First Baptist Church, Fort Gibson, Oklahoma- While in the Youth group I was a Youth Counsel Member, I helped plan and carry out youth events, mission trips, and youth choir. Through church I taught children’s church, went on visitation, nursing home visitation, and was a children’s camp counselor.
